PACKAGE CONTENTS



IMPORTANT: If your vehicle is equipped with anything but OEM turn signals (full assemblies, LED bulbs, or otherwise) in the head lights or elsewhere: You may experience a hyper flash and/or problem with the sequential signal setting on these taillights. This is not a defect in the taillight, and caused by un-matched impedance with your original vehicle settings.

INSTALLATION PROCESS

1. Remove the four (4) twist-on fasteners holding the trunk panel in place. Apply straight upward pressure to remove the panel from the trunk.



2. Using a panel trim tool or pliers, remove the push-clips retaining the trunk panels.



3. Remove and retain the three nuts holding the tail light on the vehicle. Unclip the stock wire harness connection. Remove the tail light.



5. Fit the stock trim panel to the new tail light assembly and click into place.



SEQUENTIAL TURN SIGNAL OPERATION



4. Remove the upper plastic trim panel from the factory tail lamp. Use a plastic trim removal tool and gently pry upward to release the clips.



6. Re-install new tail lamp in reverse order of removal.
